We cannot actually know God fully. Our attempts to get a grasp on God by natural reflection are better at telling us what God is not rather than what God is. The Church has always taught there is no contradiction between God of reason and the God of faith, but our faith takes us into realms of perception and imagination that reason struggles with.

The mystery of the Holy Trinity emerged gradually in the Church's thinking and teaching, and there have been many different ways of reflecting on it. What God reveals to us is always for our salvation. That is why God the Father sends his Son into the world. Through the coming of the Son and his sacrifice on our behalf we shall not be lost; rather we shall have eternal life. We shall enter into the mystery of God's own being. This gift is not offered just to the Son's followers. It is offered to the world. The Son has come not to condemn the world but so that through him the world might be saved. We, his followers, are the ones who proclaim that message and who try in our lives to live out the pattern of truth and love expressed in the mystery of his own life which God has shared with us.
